



HPAC Purpose & Charge

HPAC Purpose:

The Hospitality Partner Advisory Committee (HPAC) is a group of Hospitality Partners that represent the suppliers involved with FICP. The HPAC is a strategic resource for the FICP Board of Directors providing them with insight and perspective on the hospitality community to help the Board best set strategy for the association.

HPAC Eligibility Requirements:

To serve on the Hospitality Partner Advisory Committee, you must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Be an FICP Hospitality Partner in good standing for two continuous years or more (application approved by the Board; dues fully paid).
2. Be a strategic thinker focused on the big picture and the future.
3. Have attended at least three FICP Annual Conferences.
4. Have direct responsibility for sales efforts within the insurance and financial services market segments.
5. Be able to make the financial commitment to attend FICP Board of Directors meetings, the Education Forum and the Annual Conference at their own expense.
6. Have not served on the HPAC in the previous two years.

HPAC Time Commitment:

Members of the HPAC serve a three year term and meet in conjunction with the FICP Board up to three times annually. These meetings are generally in February/March, June (coinciding with the FICP Education Forum), and September/October. The Meetings are generally two days in length (one night). The HPAC also participates in occasional conference calls throughout the year. In addition, each HPAC member may serve on an FICP committee. An estimated 2-5 hours per month will be required work on each committee.

FICP is seeking a collaborative team of professionals that represent the broad sector of the Hospitality Partners that serve the FICP Community. This person would share his or her ideas to help make FICP a better association for planners and HPers.

HPAC Application process: Completed applications are due to FICP Headquarters (info@ficpnet.com) by **Friday, August 19, 2016**. The Governance Committee will carefully review all applications and make a recommendation to the FICP Board of Directors for final approval. New HPAC members will be notified and their acceptance will be announced at the Annual Conference in November.
